Policy:

The Drug Free Schools and Communities Act of 1989 requires that all institutions of higher education adopt and implement an alcohol and drug prevention program to prevent the unlawful possession, use, and distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol on institutional premises or as part of any of its activities.

KCAI's drug and alcohol policies are published annually in the Student Handbook or in hard copy that may be obtained through the Dean of Student Affairs. Enforcement of the KCAI drug and alcohol policies is a campus-wide effort. KCAI is also required to publish a biennial Drug Free Schools and Communities Report and an annual Security Report. In addition to established campus policies, students are subject to all State and Federal laws concerning the use and possession of alcohol, and other drugs. Students are expected to observe the laws of the state of Missouri or face legal prosecution.
