Policy:

The Kansas City Art Institute promotes the health, wellness, and safety of all students. Therefore, the KCAI good Samaritan and medical amnesty policy encourages students to assist others and/or receive help when needed without fear of penalty. A student under the influence of drugs or alcohol assisting another student in receiving or personally needing help and/or immediate medical attention will not be charged with a student code of conduct violation. The student involved will be required to meet with the Dean of Student Affairs, or designee, for further action and/or assessment. Determining if a violation has occurred or if the student will be granted amnesty will be made at the sole discretion of the Kansas City Art Institute.

This policy refers to isolated incidents and does not apply to those who repeatedly violate the KCAI alcohol and controlled substances and drugs policy. KCAI reserves the right to take action against students when their conduct endangers the health and safety of others.
